ImprOving Rural and regional accEss to long acting reversible contraception and medical abortion through nurse-led models of care, Tasksharing and telehealth

## SUPPORTING YOUR PRACTICE TO DELIVER COMPREHENSIVE WOMEN'S HEALTH CARE

This is an opportunity to join an exciting new study which aims to implement a collaborative nurse-led model of care in general practice (involving task-sharing between GPs and practice nurses, and where appropriate implant insertion by nurses and use of telehealth) to improve access to long-acting reversible contraception (LARC) and medical abortion for women in **rural** and **regional** Australia.

### WE ARE OFFERING GPs & PRACTICE NURSES FREE ONLINE TRAINING & SUPPORT

- **Free, accredited online training** on implant insertion and removal
- Online education on delivery of **LARC** and **medical abortion** services
- Educational outreach with **clinical experts** to assist with implementation of the nurse-led model
- Participation in a virtual Community of Practice for access to **professional peer support**, expertise and **resources** to support LARC and EMA service delivery

### IS YOUR PRACTICE ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible, general practices must:

- Be located in **rural** or **regional** Australia (MM2-MM7)
- Have at least **2 GPs** and **1 practice nurse** enrol in the study with a **practice manager** serving as a liaison
- Have some weekly **overlap** in GP-nurse clinic work-time

### STUDY BENEFITS

Potential benefits to practice and patients:

- **Enhancing** clinical care
- **Improved patient access** to care
- **Efficiencies** in service delivery
- Increasing capacity of nurses to **work to their full scope of practice** and support GP clinical care

Practices will receive financial incentives to compensate their time including:

- **\$500** reimbursement for **GPs** and **\$200** for **practice nurses** on completion of training activities
- **\$100** gift card for **practice managers** for serving as the study liaison
- **\$500** for **practices** at the end of the trial period

Potential to achieve CPD points including:

- **RACGP** (4 points) and **ACRRM accredited** contraceptive implant insertion and removal **training**
- **CPD points/hours** for participation in education (pending RACGP Category 1/ACRRM/ACN accreditation) activities
